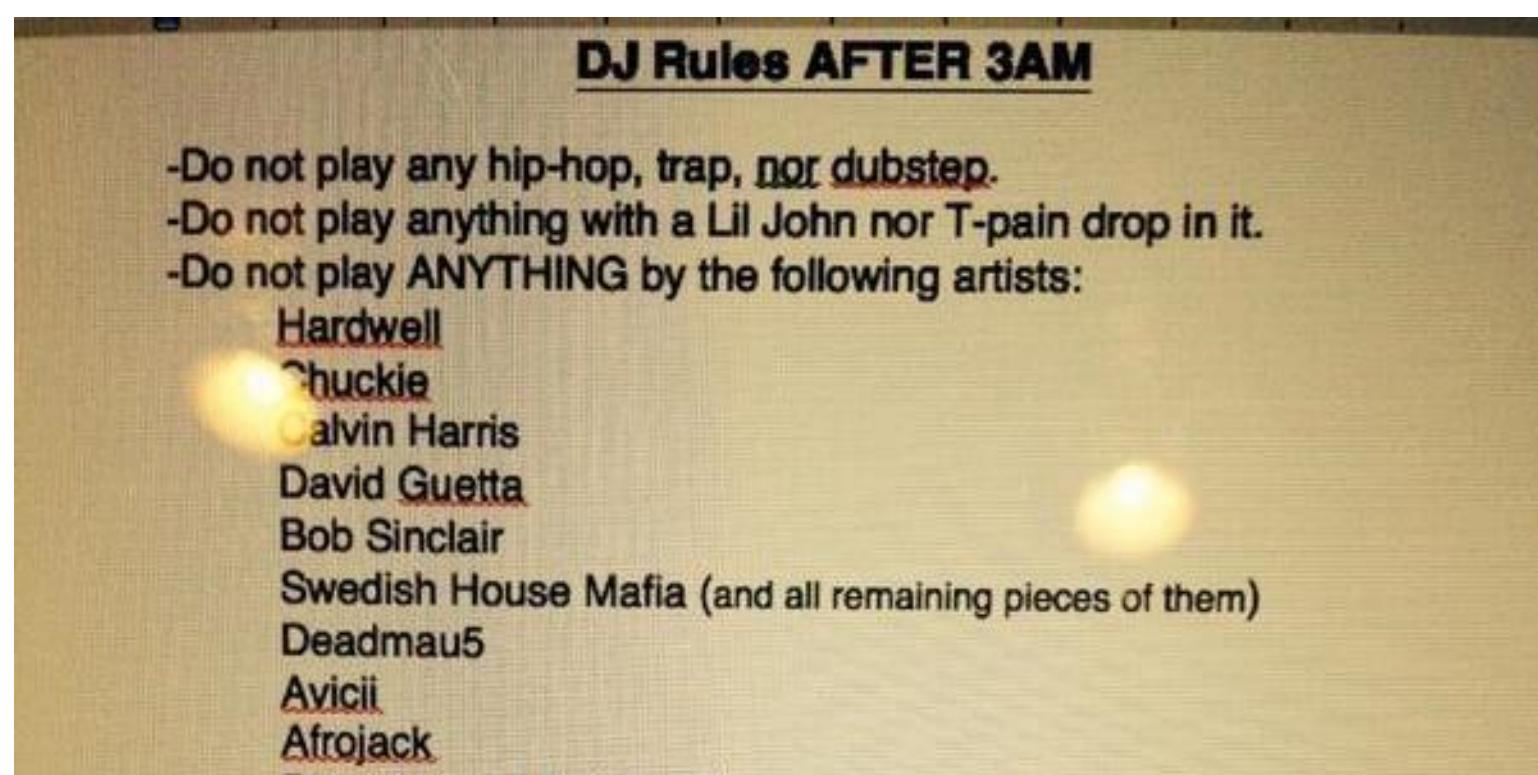


Las Vegas Club Has Awesome Rules That Ban DJs From Playing Lazy Sets Or Any ‘Mainstream Records’



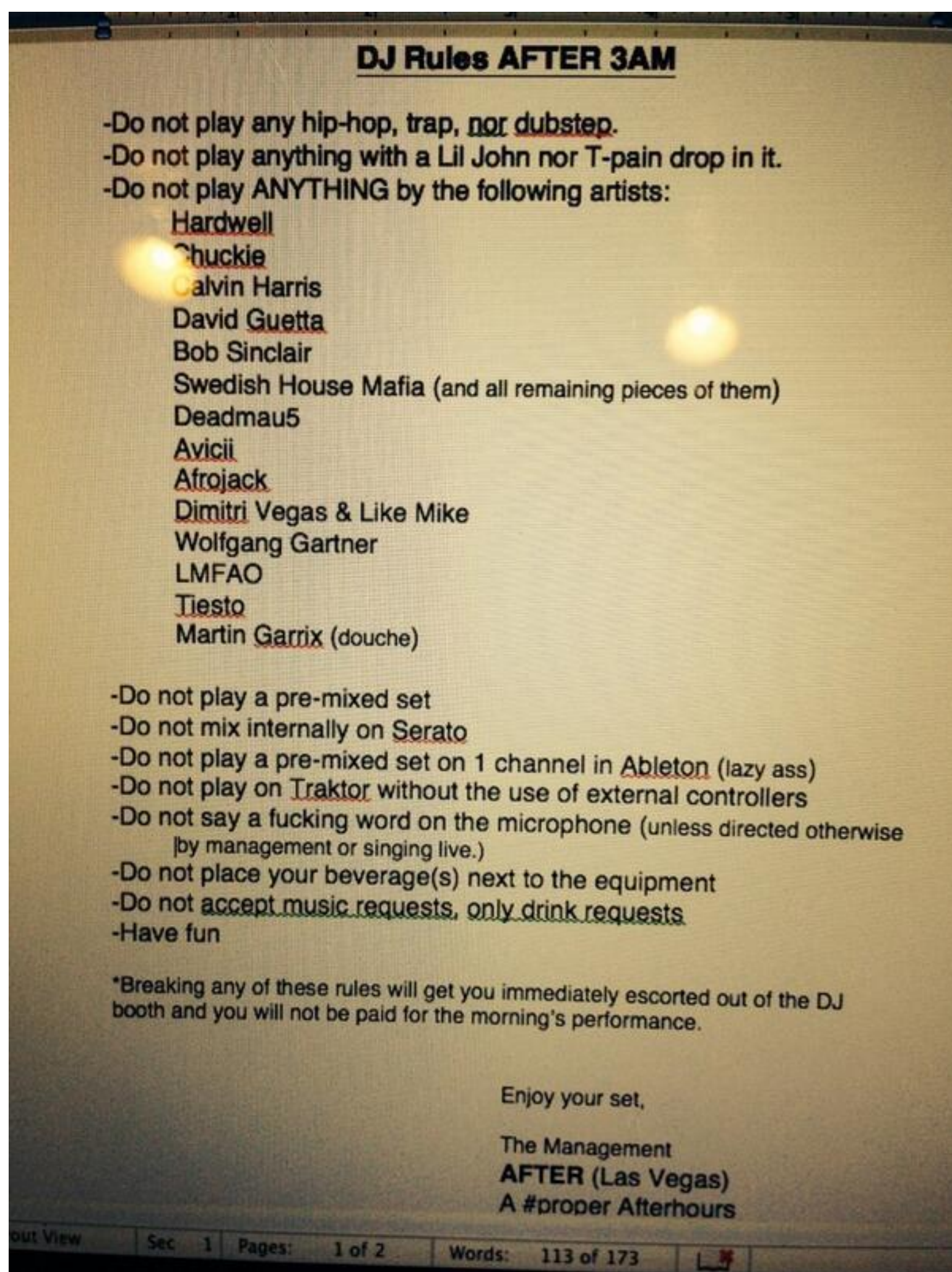
